

The safety and security of all our guests is of paramount importance at Sacramento Pride. All bags, containers, and packages are subject to search.

## GENERAL RULES:

All bags, containers, and packages are subject to search upon entering the festival.

**NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL ALLOWED.**

Guests will not be allowed to carry alcoholic beverages through the exit gates.

No weapons of any type allowed.

The City of Sacramento does not allow public use of marijuana.

Respect all festival staff, volunteers, and other festival goers.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS:

- Roller-skates or rollerblades, skateboards, and hoverboards
- Bikes or scooters (Store your bike for free at our Bike Valet)
- **NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL.** Only factory sealed disposable water bottles are permitted. All reusable water bottles, canteens, and hydration packs must be empty.
- Weapons of any kind including toy guns or water guns, knives, electric pulse weapons, large sticks, fireworks, or explosives
- Carts, tents, and chairs of any kind
- Coolers
- Bags larger than 18"x18"
- Glass containers
- Air horns, instruments, or laser pointers
- Pets, except service dogs with documentation, should be left at home for their comfort and safety. Service animals must be on a leash.
- The City of Sacramento prohibits public nudity
- Unauthorized or unlicensed vendors
- Unauthorized solicitations, handbills, sampling or giveaways
- Anyone under the age of 21 found consuming alcohol will immediately be evicted from the festival.

## WELLNESS TIPS:

- If you see something, say something. Pay attention to your surroundings and report suspicious activity or unattended packages to the nearest police officer or security personnel.
- Bring a friend with you when traveling to new and unfamiliar places.
- Keep yourself hydrated and drink plenty of water. Water is available at all of our Official Beverage Booths.
- Do not leave any valuables or personal items unattended. We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Be good to one another, look out for one another, and speak up for one another.
- Wear sunscreen. Even if it feels cool or overcast the sun can be brutal.
- If you or a friend aren't feeling well, the first aid station is located in the median between 5th and 6th streets.
- We strongly encourage pet owners to leave animals at home. It is likely to be hot and loud, making it uncomfortable for your pet.
